Player Code of Conduct



- Play in accordance with the rules of the game.
- Never argue with an official. If a player disagrees with a decision, ask your team manager to speak with the ground
- manager to raise your question.
- Demonstrate respect for coaches and club officials, stop talking when the coach is.
- Control their temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an
- opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport and may be a breach of your state, league or
- national Member Protection Policy.
- Never engage in any type of violence either on or off the field;
- Work equally hard for themselves and their team. The team's performance will benefit, and so will the player's.
- Be a 'good sport', applaud all good plays whether their team or the opposition makes them.
- Treat all participants as they would like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Shake hands with coach/manager before and after the game.
- Shake hands with opposition after each game.
- Cooperate with coaches, officials, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of the gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Not take part in any form of bullying including via the use of social media.
- Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.
